- 3- "After the first few weeks, Rhiannon decided not to go back to school. So my first hurdle was getting her back into the classroom. Finally, after two months, she went back to school and that was a big relief."
- 4- Rhiannon achieved high enough grades to study at college. "I was so proud the day she finished her studies," says Chelsea. "I felt proud of myself, too. I wished mum was around."
- 5- After college, Rhiannon, now 19, had a job and moved into her own flat. "She's an adult now and it's important that she relies on herself."
